

# Teamsters Organizing at UPS Freight:



From coast to coast, the majority of more than 5,300 of our fellow UPS Freight workers have signed cards to become Teamsters. And that number is growing every day.

Soon, our coworkers who have signed cards will fight for fair wages at the bargaining table. Our UPS Freight coworkers in Indianapolis have already negotiated wage increases of \$4.65 per hour over the life of their contract. Indianapolis workers also won overtime after working eight hours a day or 40 hours a week, a big improvement over past practice. Indianapolis workers also won paid delay time, where previously they received none.
